This notice serves to inform all exporters of livestock and livestock products from Namibia regarding the export related testing performed at the Central Veterinary Laboratory (CVL) price alignment.

In an effort to maintain CVL functionality and eliminate disruptions in trade, the prices to be paid for export related tests performed at the CVL will be increased to cover the actual cost of performing the test. This will allow cost recovery for consumables and reagents needed by the CVL to perform the export related tests without interruption.
