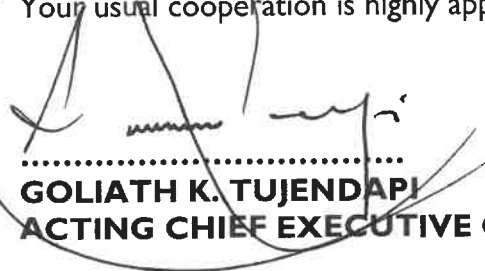
NOTICE

CHANGES IN THE LIVESTOCK AND LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS TRADE PERMIT REGIME

After Consultation with industry, the Board, in an effort to improve trade facilitation approved the following changes in the livestock and livestock products permit regime:

1. LLPBN Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for Permit Management have been amended to allow change of ownership of consignments of controlled products kept in registered bonded facilities subject to compliance with the Livestock and Livestock Products Act (Act No. 12 of 1981), the Animal Health Act (Act No. 1 of 2011), the Customs and Excise Act (Act No. 20 of 1998) and any other relevant legislation relating to the movement and trade of goods. This change will allow registered importers that do not have sufficient poultry and pork import quota to transfer their consignments to other importers who have sufficient quota by way of selling such consignments. The LLPBN is currently engaged in a process of making the computerised Trade Facilitation System ready for implementation and registered stakeholders will be informed by electronic mail of the specific technical requirements relating to this provision.
2. Standard Operating Procedures for Permit Management have also been amended to allow Transit Permits to run for a validity period of 14 days instead of 7 days. This will allow traders sufficient time to make necessary documentary and logistical arrangements to ensure the exit of products permitted for transit to exit the Republic of Namibia. The implementation of this change is effective immediately.
3. It is hoped that these changes will improve trade facilitation and contribute to the competitive positioning of Namibia's livestock and livestock products industry.
