

NOTICE: EUROPEAN UNION 90/40 DAY RESIDENCY OUTREACH PROGRAM

Hereby, the public is informed that the Livestock and Livestock Products Board of Namibia (LLPBN) in collaboration with the Directorate of Veterinary Services and the Namibia National Farmers Union (NNFU) scheduled an outreach program that will deliberate on the challenges that communal producers experience pertaining to the requirement of the European Union 90/40 day residency period. The objective of the two-week outreach program aim to provide communal producers south of the Veterinary Cordon Fence to discuss their challenges in accessing the EU export, slaughter value chain with special reference to the 90/40 day residency.

This requirement entails that an animal destined for the EU market, prior to slaughtering, should have been a resident in the Namibian FMD free zone for 90 days and the last 40 days at a registered establishment (farm).

Four Delegations will visit the identified regions on and at predetermined dates and venues.

Delegation 1: Khomas Region: 21 – 24 September 2026
Otjozondjupa Region: 25 September - 1 October 2026

Delegation 2: Omaheke Region: 21 September – 1 October 2026

Delegation 3: Hardap Region: 21 – 24 September 2026
Karas Region: 28 September – 2 October 2026

Delegation 4: Kunene Region (South): 21 – 25 September 2026
Erongo Region: 28 September – 02 October 2026
