PUBLIC NOTICE ON THE REPEAL OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 54 OF 28 FEBRUARY 2020 AND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE POULTRY MARKET SHARE PROMOTION SCHEME BY THE LIVESTOCK AND LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS BOARD OF NAMIBIA

The Livestock and Livestock Products Board of Namibia (LLPBN) hereby inform all members of the public, importers, exporters, poultry producers, processors, traders, and other stakeholders that Government Notice No. 54 of 28 February 2020 (Restrictions on Importation of Poultry Products into Namibia), issued under the Import and Export Control Act, 1994 (Act No. 30 of 1994), has been repealed with immediate effect by Government Notice No. 123 of 01 April 2026 issued by the Ministry of International Relations and Trade.

To support the growth of the local poultry sector, the LLPBN will implement, with immediate effect, the Poultry Market Share Promotion Scheme (PMSS) as a permit condition in terms of section 3 of the LLP Act, and subparagraph (x) of section 10(1) of the Act, read together with Government Notices 387 of 13 December 2024 (issued under section 20 of the Act), 381 of 13 December 2024 (issued under section 24(1) of the Act), and 382 of 13 December 2024 (issued under section 17(1) of the Act). As such:

- All imports of poultry products into Namibia (except those specified to be outside the Poultry Market Share Promotion Scheme as approved by the BOARD of the LLPBN) will be subject to import quotas and will require a valid import permit issued by the LLPBN;
- Importers must register with the LLPBN to obtain a producer number and apply for permits in accordance with the LLPBN's Poultry Market Share Promotion Scheme Standard Operating Procedures and notified quota allocations;
- All other statutory requirements, including veterinary import permits, animal health standards under the Animal Health Act, quality controls and applicable levies, remain fully in force;
- Producers that wish to participate in the Scheme are required to register their interest by completion of the relevant form and compliance to appropriate veterinary requirements applicable to poultry establishments.
