The Livestock and Livestock Products Board of Namibia (LLPBN) is looking to fund two selected students enrolled for a post-graduate qualification in the following fields:

Veterinary Science; Animal Science; Agricultural Economics or any other field related to livestock and livestock products. The following research/specialization fields will be prioritized:

FIELDS OF RESEARCH/SPECIALIZATION:

- FMD vaccine potency vs field strain matching for effective disease control;
- Regenerative farming and the challenges of communal and pastoral farming systems;
- Carbon footprint and carbon credits of Namibian beef;
- Intensive poultry and dairy production in the Namibian environment;
- Agricultural Trade Policy: To strengthen Namibia's agricultural trade policy to enhance competitiveness, support industrial development, and position the sector for regional and global trade opportunities.
- Genomic Data Science: Research that applies genomic science to develop drought-resilient, high-performing livestock breeds that improve productivity, reduce risk, and strengthen Namibia's livestock industry.
- Regulatory Economics: Research that enhances the design of effective regulatory frameworks to support competitive markets, industrial development, and sustainable economic growth in Namibia

- Successful completion of a suitable academic degree.
- Namibian citizen
- Interest in pursuing a career in the Namibian livestock industry after successful completion of post-graduate qualification.

- Motivation Letter highlighting your research and its contribution to the livestock and livestock products industry.
- Certified proof of academic degree (s) obtained, with academic record.
- Certified proof of enrolment or acceptance confirmation from a recognized Tertiary Institution for post-graduate qualification. (Recognition of Tertiary Institution by the relevant regulatory body, or alternatively NQA)
- Certificate of registration from a relevant regulating body (where applicable).
- Proof of Namibian Citizenship.
- Disclosure of other sources of financial support.
