

INVITATION TO APPLY FOR A SHARE IN THE NORWEGIAN BEEF EXPORT QUOTA 2026

Eligible organisations are in terms of the LLPBN Standard Operating Procedures for Norway Quota (SOP 2.1) invited to apply to the Livestock and Livestock Products of Namibia for a share in the Norwegian quota available to Namibia for the production and export of beef to Norway. The quota will be awarded to eligible organisations (organisations approved for beef production and export to Norway) and is valid for the period beginning 1 January 2026 to 31 December 2026. New entrants that meet requirements are encouraged to apply.

The sharing and allocation of the 1 600 tons of beef quota will be done in accordance with the principles outlined in the Cabinet Decision 15th /03.09.24/001 for the export of beef to Norway as well as the LLPBN Norway Quota Standard Operating Procedures (14 November 2024). The quantities applied for must be in compliance with 2.2.3 and 2.2.4 of the LLPBN Norway Quota Standard Operating Procedures (14 November 2024).

Applicants are required to attach the following documents/information:

- 1. A covering letter motivating for the award of the quota and stipulating the total tonnage applied for the calendar year 2026
- 2. Statutory documents proving incorporation of legal entity
- 3. Historic slaughter numbers and beef export volumes indicating demonstrated capacity to export the beef tonnage applied for
- 4. A production plan indicating envisaged slaughter number for 2026 Commitment Schedule indicating the envisaged quantities to be exported in each respective month totalling to the quantity applied for
- 5. Proof of compliance with corporate statutory requirements including clearance of LLPBN levies as at date of application
- 6. Existing beneficiaries of the quota must ensure that a full disclosure of consignments (with LLPBN permit numbers) undertaken and cleared in 2024 is attached to the application.

Written applications, clearly marked "Norwegian Quota" should reach the LLPBN on or before 16 October 2025 and should be addressed in a confidential envelop to:
