

## MUTTON Monthly Market Watch

### November 2023 Review

November witnessed a growth of live sheep exports by 11.21% from the 38 699 heads exported in October. This is 50.56% more than what was recorded a year ago. Slaughter at export abattoirs also experienced growth where 6.13% more sheep were slaughtered compared to the previous month, and is 62.79% more than what was slaughtered last year. A2 prices increased by 3.08% on an m-o-m basis, from the October price level of N\$74.82/kg but remain 6.93% lower than they were a year ago. C2 Prices on the other hand experienced muted monthly decline of 0.66%. Prices are however 15.23% less than they were a year ago.



99% of Exports went to South Africa, of which 71.66% went for slaughter purposes and 27.74 went to feedlots. The remaining 1% of live exports went to Botswana, for farming and breeding purposes.

Live sheep exports to feedlots increased by 12.32% compared to the previous month whereas export to South African abattoirs declined by 11.89%.



Australian prices have been on an upward trend since September indicating a turnaround of events compared to the first 8 months of the year. Prices have increased by 2.05% from the October price level of N\$44.79/kg, and 30.30% from the September price level of N\$35.08/kg. The improvement in prices is expected to remain stable, however supply is set to increase as the spring crop enters the market. Although there has been rainfall experienced mostly in Southern Australia, the dry outlook continues to be a limiting factor contributing the heightened supply of lambs in the market.

South African A2 have trended sideways between October and November experiencing a 1% decline in observed prices. Seasonal trends indicate increases in prices over the festive period however, prices are expected to remain under pressure over the coming months.



# CHEVON Monthly Market Watch Of Namibia

### November 2023 Review

Goat Live exports experienced a monthly decline of 11.18% from the 13 945 heads exported in October. This is 10.61% lower than it was a year ago. 98% of all goats were exported to South Africa where the majority went to feedlots (87.56%). The remaining 2% of live exports were split between other SADC countries where 1% went to Zimbabwe, 0.3% went to Botswana, 0.2% to Zambia and 0.1% to Angola.
