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Mutton Monthly Market Watch



April 2025 Review

Total marketing of sheep decreased by 47.72%, from the 116 879 sheep marketed in April 2024 to 61 104 sheep marketed during April 2025. Live exports decreased by 39.09% year-on-year basis. Furthermore, export abattoir performance decreased by 45.84% on a year-on-year basis, while B&C class abattoir slaughtering also decreased by 83.40%, from 21 038 sheep slaughtered during April 2024 to 3 493 sheep slaughtered in April 2025.



The sheep industry is dominated by live exports. Majority of live sheep exports (99.37%) were destined to South Africa followed by Botswana with 0.60%, and Zimbabwe (0.02%).



Australian light lamb prices increased by 3.00% from N\$130.49/kg in March 2025 to N\$134.40/kg in April 2025. Australian (Light Lamb) prices increased during the review period due to increased demand and reduced supply.

Uruguay (Export Lamb) prices increased by 2.85% during the period under review. Namibian A2 sheep carcass prices increased by 34.69% on a year-on-year basis, and by 8.13% on a month-to-month basis during the period under review.



April 2025 Review

Total marketing of goats increased by 29.12%, from the 8 742 goats marketed in April 2024 to 11 288 marketed during April 2025. During the period under review, 11 269 goats were exported live compared to 8 644 exported in April 2024. Representing an increase of 30.37% on a year-on-year basis and 19.36% on a monthly basis. During the period under review, exports to South Africa made up 98.50% of total live goat exports, followed by Zimbabwe with 1.44% and Botswana with 0.06%.
