STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) FOR THE EXPORT OF SHEEP

This Notice replaces MBN Sheep Marketing Scheme Notice issued on 3 August 2018.

The Meat Board of Namibia wishes to inform the sheep industry that the Notice issued on 3 August 2018, as a result of the closure of Brukarros Meat Processors (Pty) Ltd remains in place until 15 November 2018. This extension was necessitated to consult the industry on a long term solution which will benefit both the producers and abattoirs.

Producers are informed on the following conditions with respect to the export of sheep:

- a) Producers are advised to continue slaughter locally,
- b) A producer wishing to export sheep
 - I. Could apply at the Meat Board of Namibia (via a Meat board of Namibia agent) for the export of livestock;
 - II. Such producer should show proof of numbers of sheep slaughtered the past six months at any abattoir registered with the Meat Board of Namibia and that such abattoir demonstrate paid up levies:
 - III. Such producer should first use his/her available quota;
- c) The Meat Board will have sole discretion when issuing a permit to export controlled product.
- d) The quantity of sheep to be exported will not exceed the quantity of sheep slaughtered the past six months
